Supplier Evaluation Risk Rating™ (SER)

Predicts suppliers that will cease operations or become inactive over the next 12 months based on depth of predictive data attributes available on the supplier

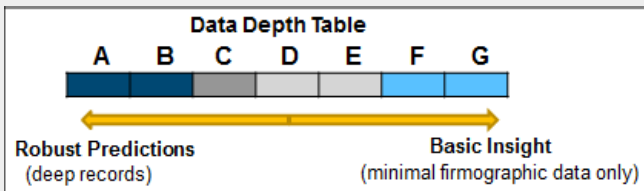

Supplier Evaluation Risk Rating™ (SER)

- Predicts the likelihood that a supplier will cease operations, regardless of debt outstanding, or become inactive over the next 12 months based on depth of predictive data on the supplier in D&B records.
- Score ranges from 1 to 9, with 1 indicating the lowest risk and 9 indicating the highest risk.
- Model tailored to represent commercial entities that are characteristic of supplier risk management space.
- SER incorporates A-G Data Depth indicator measuring availability of predictive data on a supplier



The Data Depth indicator uses H-M scale to help customers alert to special categories such as open bankruptcy, business deterioration and others.

Supplier Stability Indicator (SSI)

- Predicts the likelihood that a supplier will cease operations, reorganize, seek legal relief, or cause a significant supply chain disruption over the next 3 months.
- Score ranges from 0 to 10, with 0 indicating the lowest risk and 10 indicating highest risk.
- Model developed and validated exclusively on D&B's database of suppliers.

PAYDEX Score

- D&B's unique dollar-weighted numerical indicator of how a firm paid its bills over the past year, based on trade experiences reported to D&B by various vendors.
- The D&B PAYDEX® ranges from 1 to 100, with higher scores indicating better payment performance.
